#### **DECISIONS**

During March, ERE Board held 2 meetings, which resulted in 10 decision-making, among which the licensing of one subject in electricity production activity, the licensing of two subjects in electricity supply activity, the suspension of the decision-making regarding the review of a subject's request for licensing in electricity production activity, until the fulfillment of the predetermined conditions, the opening of the procedure for the renewal of a license in electricity trading activity, as well as some amendments in the predetermined conditions in decision-making for two subjects licensed in electricity production activity.

Among others it can also be mentioned:

- The opening of the procedure to review the request of DSO company for some additions and amendments in the "Regulation on new connections in the distribution system", approved by ERE Board decision no. 166, dated 10.10.2016, as amended.
- The approval of the request of the Albanian Association of Electricity Suppliers (AAES) for some amendments and restrictions in the implementation of ERE board decision no. 186, dated 06.06.2023.
- The opening of the procedure for reviewing and approving the general conditions of the Contract for Difference, as a provision of Article 14 of Law no. 24/2023 "On promoting the use of energy from renewable sources".

#### **HEARING SESSIONS**

On March 7 and 8, representatives of the **Energy Regulator Authority participated in the** joint meeting of the Energy Regulators Regional Association, ERRA "On Electricity Market and Economic Issues" and "On Renewable Energy", and also at the meeting of the Commission for the Natural Gas Market and Economic Issues, organized in Bratislava, Slovakia. In these meetings, the participants presented the challenges of the flexibility of the electric energy system in the context of decarbonization and the penetration of renewable energy sources, the options of creating a flexible energy network, market models for balancing, and discussed the work plans for 2024-2026 period. ERE representatives presented the electricity market model in Albania and the latest developments in the sector.

In the meeting with the Natural Gas Commission, the participants presented studies related to the injection of biomethane into the distribution system, the distribution tariff, the effects of the digital transformation of the natural gas market, etc. ERE representatives presented the current situation of the natural gas sector in Albania.

During March, hearing sessions with licensed subjects and interested parties were also part of ERE activity, with the aim of resolving disputes or obtaining the positions of the parties in order to make a more complete decision.

Among them it can mentioned a hearing session conducted by the Licensing, Authorizations and Supervision Directory with Albgaz company which basically had clarifications and discussions on the subject's compliance report; as well as a hearing session under the guidance of the Legal and Dispute Resolution Directory, regarding the problem generated between TSO company, FTL company and Dragobia Energy company on the notification of the contract by Dragobia Energy company, for the sale of electricity in March 2024.
